Dolphins.

Dolphins are really considered to be small toothed whales and grow to approximately 6 feet in length. They can be found in virtually all the seas and oceans. They are predators and feed on live food. Their intelligence is well documented, and they are capable of making sounds like a buzz and/ or ducklike quack.

Sea Lion.

Sea Lions are a member of the eared seal family. Their bodies are covered with short coarse hair. There are 4 major kinds of Sea Lions. The Californian Sea Lion, The North Pacific Sea Lion, the South American Sea Lion and the Australian/New Zealand Sea Lion. The Sea Lion is capable of diving 600 feet for food

Sea Otter.

The Sea otter is a member of the weasel family and is about 3.5 feet long. Sea otters are found along the North Pacific. They eat and sleep floating on their backs and are one of the few to use tools (rocks to crack shells) to get to their food.

Killer Whales.

Killer Whales also called Orcas were hunted extensively in the 1900's. Their blubber was sold as lamp oil, and their ribs or bones were used in garments as supports. Some famous authors have written about the whale hunting, One comes immediately to mind, namely, Herman Melville.

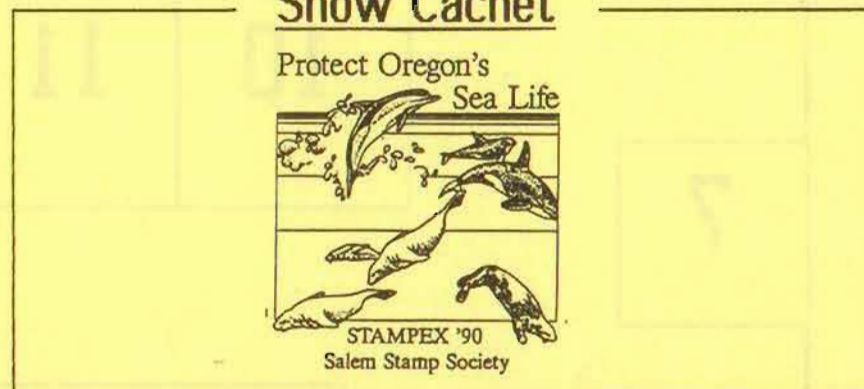
