PIPEX 2019

PIPEX 2019 is an American Philatelic Society World Series of Philately show sponsored by Portland Philatelic Exhibitions on behalf of Oregon Stamp Society and the Northwest Federation of Stamp Clubs. The official corporate sponsor of PIPEX 2019 is Uptown Stamp Show.

Make your plans to go to the show. It is the largest stamp show in the Pacific Northwest.

The show will be held on May 10 - 12 at the Red Lion Hotel on the River at Jantzen Beach, located at 909 North Hayden Island Drive, in Portland. Parking at the hotel is free. If you want to stay at the show, the discounted room rate for people going to PIPEX is \$105 per night. Call (503) 283-4466 for reservations. You may also make reservations on the PIPEX 2019 website: www.pipexstampshow.org. On Sunday, the hotel offers an excellent Mother's Day Brunch for which

reservations are required. Reserve early, because it can sell out.

Admission to the show is free. Show hours are 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on Friday and Saturday and 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Sunday.

There will be a 40 table dealer bourse and 3800 pages of exhibits. The show will also feature StampBuddy for beginning or returning adult collectors, a youth area (that will offer free stamps by the bucket each day), and Grandma's Attic where people can bring their stamp collections to be evaluated.

National and international societies holding their meetings at the show are: American Revenue Society and State Revenue Society. The Northwest Federation of Stamp Clubs will hold its annual general meeting at the show. The Pacific Northwest Postal History Society will hold a meeting and present a program.

Most societies meeting at the show present one or more programs worth seeing and are open to all. Societies expected to be represented at the show, in addition to those mentioned above, include American Philatelic Society, American Topical Association, Northwest Philatelic Library, Northwest Chapter of the American Airmail Society, and our own Salem Stamp Society. (Note: our club table will need staffing. Please volunteer to spend some time there when needed. Also, it's a good place to socialize with other club

members at the show.)

Harmer-Schau Auctions Northwest will hold an auction at the show on Sunday, May 12. Auction lots may be viewed each day of the show and online before the show at their website: info@harmerschau.com.

Exhibits will be judged by a panel of five judges accredited by the APS. Kathy Johnson is the chief judge.

Other judges are Mark Banchik, Alan Warren, Jane Sodero, and Stephane Cloutier. Mark Loomis, chair of the PIPEX 2019 Committee, may serve as an apprentice judge.

As a WSP show, the multi-frame exhibit Grand Award winner is expected to compete in the Champion of Champions competition at StampShow 2019 in Omaha, Nebraska, on August 1-4, 2019. The single-frane Grand Award winner is expected to compete in the single-frame Champion of Champions competition at the St Louis Stamp Expo in St Louis, Missouri on March 27-29.

In case you were wondering, this means that top level exhibits are competing at PIPEX 2019. Allow time to see the exhibits and see very fine philatelic material you may not see again.

The show awards dinner will take place on Saturday evening at the Red Lion Hotel. Reservations are required and can be made by contacting Steve Brandt at: zbear@att.net. Early reservations are encouraged because the event may sell out before the show opens.

It is especially valuable to anyone who has not attended a major stamp show before. Thanks again to Gary for writing this piece.

HOW TO ATTEND A MAJOR STAMP SHOW

The first day is usually crowded and busy, especially in the first 3 - 4 hours. Come later in the day.

Dealers do not raise prices just because it is a major show. They do bring expensive and rare material, knowing many who attend are looking for such. Regular stock will be available.

Bring specific want lists. This saves time for you and the dealer. Refrain from saying: "I forgot my list".

Limit your time at an obviously busy booth, if you are just browsing. Be sensitive to available space and customer traffic in that case.

Absolutely visit the exhibits - it is your opportunity to view world class

and very rare material.

Use your show program for a directory of where dealers are located. Circulate and scope out the "lay of the room" to determine your stamp hunting itinerary.

Most dealers do not organize their material by topic, but it is ok to ask about a topic - since many know their material well enough to help you.

Most dealers take credit cards, but ask before you start your search. Checks and cash work too!

Food will be expensive at the hotel - arrgh! (But there are several restaurants nearby at Jantzen Beach, with price ranges to suit everyone).

Never try to sell to another customer at a dealer's booth since they have paid a lot of money for selling their material, not yours.

Take some time to sit down, relax, and enjoy the atmosphere of a major show - it is unique.

Do not forget to check out the schedule of specialize seminars listed in the show program. You will be in the presence of experts and specialists.

Drop by our club booth - you might be needed for company, encouragement, or short relief.

(Editor's note: Visit the society booths and ask when they will be presenting a program for their members. Visitors are usually always welcome to hear the program).
