We were treated to an excellent presentation by Al Furtwangler who talked about a fascinating story revealed by a box of post cards he bought at a recent club auction. He is more of a user of postcards and postage than a stamp collector as he described to us last year. In this collection he found a number of postcards with a common theme. With further research it turned out that these cards came from members of a local basketball team on tour in 1909. Postcards were sent home from all across the US. The team from Dallas College was sponsored in an effort to promote Oregon at these tour games.

A very nice write up of the tour illustrated by the postcards and the correspondence was circulated during the meeting.

Gary Tiffin also presented his popular talk on "What to do and what not to do" at stamp exhibitions in preparation for PIPEX.

Finally, 46 out of 60 lots listed on the April Bid Board sold for just under \$400.

PIPEX 2022

PIPEX has just closed as this Newsletter is being prepared and all the indications are that it has been a very successful event. Photographs below of part of the Exhibition and Bourse dealer areas on the Saturday morning reflect busy and lively scenes throughout the show.

There were about 170 frames of exhibits which included some outstanding and unique items and a wide variety of interesting and well-researched



subjects. One exhibit that caught my attention was the "Anti-British Propaganda and caricature post-cards of the second Anglo-Boer War" by Hugh Sebag-Montefiore. He is a well known author of books on military history and had assembled a very impressive collection of material to illustrate this controversial episode in the story of the British Empire. A list of Awards will be given in the next Newsletter.

There were 23 dealer booths at the show which occupied 3 interconnected areas of the center and all those that I spoke to said that they were doing good business. It was certainly difficult to find a vacant chair at some of the booths!

For the first time (I believe) the show included a silent auction where bids were entered on sheets during a fixed period over two days. There were 100 lots comprising single stamps to large collections / accumulations and starting bids varying from a few \$ to \$2500 The lots were assembled by Bob Reynolds who oversaw the viewing and bidding process with his wife Loren. Bob reports that the auction grossed just over \$5000.

There were three convening societies at PIPEX this year: the German Philatelic Society, United



States Stamp Society and the Pacific Northwest Postal History Society. Each of these societies had their own tables to describe their activities. Our Salem Stamp Society table manned by volunteers provided members with an opportunity to meet up with friends and exchange news on their new acquisitions.

Major shows such as PIPEX require a lot of time, planning and effort. We are grateful to the PIPEX Organizing Committee under the chairmanship of Mark Loomis for mounting such an enjoyable, interesting and well-run event this year.
