## **Congratulations to George Struble!**

In the July 2023 edition of "The American Philatelist" it was announced that George has been awarded a National Service Award by the APS. The citation lists his activities and contributions to national philately over nearly 50 years. George's local contributions to our society, PIPEX, the Greater Eugene Stamp Society and our STAMPEX are appreciated and well known to our members. He will be traveling to GASS in Cleveland later this month to accept his reward.

## **Dr Anthony S. Wawrukiewicz, 1943-2023.**

It was announced last month that the highly respected philatelist and postal history researcher Anthony Wawrukiewicz died on July 11th.



Although not a member of SSS, Tony W was known to many of us through his contributions to PIPEX. His books on US postal history have become standard reference works and he contributed a regular monthly column to Linn's Stamp News on Modern US Mail.

He was an accomplished exhibitor and a retired national judge. He received many awards for services to philately including the 2002 APS Luff Award for distinguished philatelic research and the Northwest Distinguished Philatelist Award—the NW Federation of Stamp Clubs highest honor.

He was actively involved with the PIPEX organizing committee for many years and was given the PIPEX 2022 Service Award.

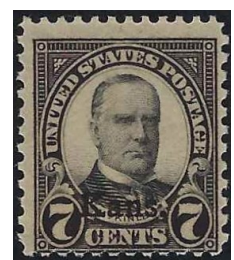

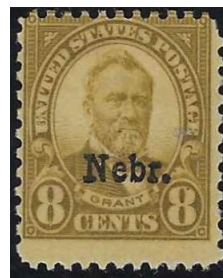
