Club News, Shows & Meetings.

There will be gifts for everyone at our Christmas Party on Wednesday December 4th starting at 6pm. Bob Reynolds has arranged a very special star prize this year, one lucky member will win one of the Recalled Legends of the West mint sheets. A short time before the scheduled release of this striking commemorative sheet in March 1994, it was discovered that Ben Pickett was erroneously pictured in place of the legendary Bill Pickett, the first African-American cowboy to be inducted into the National Rodeo Hall of Fame. The Post Office Department hastily withdrew all sheets from circulation, but 183 had already been sold before the official first day of issue - some of which later brought up to \$15,000! To diffuse the uproar, a lottery sale of 150,000 sheets was announced for single orders postmarked on October 1, 1994. The small quantities sold through the lottery have made this sheet highly collectable.

The other philatelic and non-philatelic prizes have not been disclosed but they are bound to be fun and desirable items. Be sure to sign up at the next meeting to let the Scottish Rite Center know numbers attending. You will be able to select you're your choice of dinner (prime rib, salmon or a vegetarian option) at that time. Ticket prices are \$25 per head (which includes a gratuity).
